Emerging Leader Award

Kent State University's Omega Nu chapter of the Order of Omega was founded under the auspices of recognizing high standards of leadership among fraternity men and sorority women. These individuals are called together to inspire others in their community to strive for that same standard.

The Order of Omega Emerging Leader Award was established for this purpose- to recognize the next generation of community members embracing and working towards achieving their leadership potential. To be eligible for this award, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a first or second year Kent State University student
- Demonstrate a commitment to the founding purposes of the Greek community- scholarship, service, leadership, and social excellence
- Be actively involved in their chapter and the greater Greek community
- Maintain at least a 3.0 GPA
- Obtain a recommendation letter from one member of their e-board

The recommendation letter must outline the leadership qualities the applicant has demonstrated during their semesters of membership and why they are viewed as an emerging leader. **All applications will be due to the Center of Student Involvement by March 30, 2012 attn: Order of Omega.** The selected recipients, one fraternity man and one sorority woman, will be named at the Greek Closing Ceremonies on April 25, 2012.
